SPEECH CONTEST 2022 / II Liceum Ogólnokształcące w Zamościu / RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The purpose of the contest is to give the participants an opportunity to express themselves. The competition allows students to demonstrate and test their proficiency and fluency in English.
- 2. The Speech Contest is organized by High School II in Zamość on the initiative of Joanna Mazur and Elżbieta Paszko.
- 3. All the participants taking part are the students of High School II in Zamość.
- 4. The contest will be held on December 19 at 10.30 a.m. in classroom no. 4 in High School II in Zamość.
- 5. Each contestant shall choose one out of the five topics provided by the organizers.
- 6. Speeches must be between 5 and 7 minutes in length. Penalty points will be applied for time infractions at the rate of 1 point for every 1 minute. Students shall obtain appropriate feedback after their performance.
- 7. Contestants must create their OWN speeches. Each participant is obliged to provide the content of their speech in written form 3 days before the day of the competition, so that the organizers can check that it is substantively original (except for quotes, which are welcome).
- 8. A microphone will be provided. No other props are to be used.
- 9. Students are allowed to use a bulleted list of ideas helping them provide the speech (maximum 10 entries, full sentences are forbidden). The list must be presented to the judges right before giving the speech.
- 10. Contestants will be evaluated by a panel of judges consisting of teachers and students of High School II in Zamość. Participants may obtain 20 points altogether.
